CORONA-SAFE CONDITIONS FOR VISITORS

- Please buy your ticket(s) online from <u>www.oertijdmuseum.nl</u> and plan your visit within the indicated time slots.
- The museum building is accessible for wheelchairs and big-size prams although the one-way route through the museum contains a staircase upwards. However it is possible to use a ramp (in the opposite walking route) if not crowded. Smaller prams and baby buggies can follow the indoor route, but have to be carried up a staircase. Pull carts are not allowed in the museum building and garden. If you wish, you can hire one at the spot.
- Do not come early or late, but present yourself at the reception desk within the allotted time slot. If there are more visitors at the reception desk, join the queue.
- If, despite all our precautions to prevent this, there should be more visitors than allowed, museum staff will ask you to not enter the museum parking and/or the museum and/or the Prehistory Garden. If you have already entered the parking, and/or the museum and/or the Prehistory Garden, you will be asked to leave.
- Particularly when it is crowded we advise against using the cloakroom; we prefer if you leave your possessions in your car as much as possible.
- The indicated route is mandatory, both inside the museum building, and outside in the Prehistory Garden.
- Catering and souvenir shop are open.
- We prefer payments with debit cards.
- Please obey instructions given by the museum staff.
- Keep a distance of 1.5 metres (5 feet) from others.
- If you are ill or unwell, we urge you to postpone your visit for your own safety, and that of others.
